

Call for Proposals 2017

«Inserm - University Chairs» Program

Inserm in partnership with universities and according to the needs of the universities, proposes, in the field of Life Science and Health, to host Associate Professor or Full Professor, in a context of a Chair position.

This program aims to attract talented researchers, at early stages of their careers, to thematic positions defined jointly by Inserm and the university, according to a common scientific strategy.

Candidates are selected by both, the university and Inserm, and are recruited as Associate Professor or Full Professor by the university and placed by delegation at Inserm.

The five-year Chair appointment, allows these associate professors or full professors to concentrate on developing their research program in an appropriate scientific environment. Their teaching schedule is limited to one-third of their time.

In addition to their salary, recipients of an Inserm-University Chair position receive a substantial bonus and financial support for their research.

These Chair appointments are available not only to post-doctoral researcher candidates for a first associate or full professor position, but also to associate or full professors applying for transfer. Research scientists wishing to convert to teaching positions can also apply.

Applications procedures are the same as for associate professor or full professor position and therefore require that a candidate be “qualified” by the Higher Education board.
